- **From PA points east:** US 30 west past York, at intersection with PA 116 (stay on 30), 5.4 miles to Lake Road (on the left). Paradise Elementary School is on the right.
- **From Gettysburg:** US 30 through Abbottstown, go 3 miles to Lake Road (on right, across from Paradise Elementary School on north side of Rte 30), turn south onto Lake Road. Follow about 2 miles until you see the lake on the right; 2nd brick house on the right.
- **From Hanover:** PA 116 through Spring Grove to Jackson Street (2 blocks after 2nd railroad tracks) turn left onto Jackson; take to end (high school on left). Turn left onto Hanover Street; go 1/4 mile to Lake Road (first road to the right). Turn right (north) onto Lake Road; follow ~ 1 mile until the lake is visible. First house on the left (large red garage and red brick house) is Miller's.
