1. Finalized 250 Bucket Challenge plans:
 - This past Sunday the 90 buckets returned were inventoried.
 - Before our meeting, Peg and John O, Amy and Kevin and Jim Hollinger met to place the lids on the buckets. All buckets (filled and infilled), lids and supplies were placed in the baptistery for storage. Peg and Amy went over the list of needed supplies for the remaining buckets. Order will be placed after Amy returns from her vacation. Cases and pallets of supplies will be stored in Memorial Lobby alcoves upon delivery.
 - June 2nd. After Church the youth will assemble the buckets. We will invite others from the congregation to help if needed. We will supply lunch(pizza, brownies and drink) to all of the helpers . Amy will check with the 20's & 30's class about carrying the supplies down to the stage during SS to organize the supplies for the assembly line.
 - June 6th. The buckets will be delivered to a UCC church in Harrisburg (a drop off site for CWS). Amy has reserved this date with them. Bob McFarland has secured a box truck which he will drive for us. We will need to secure helpers for that day to load/unload the buckets.
 - We brainstormed ideas for the churches we are going to challenge....Chiques, Manchester, LaVerne, Wyomissing, others??? We will make the challenge video and post on social media in conjunction with the bucket assembly on June 2nd.
2. Community Cupboard collection is ongoing for the month of May with a table in the vestibule to the left of the Sanctuary door.
3. CROP table will be from May 5th. through mid October.
4. We briefly discussed Jim Hollinger 's big idea. We all agreed to give this subject some thought for more discussion to follow at our June meeting.
