At a recent Special Church Council **Meeting**, our congregation voted to move forward with building a multipurpose gathering space—a new pavilion designed for fellowship events, community meals, children's activities, and other ministries that connect and strengthen us. The project will proceed once we have secured 75% of the total cost in pledges. We have secured 26.5% of our goal so far of \$465,000.
